

Life, Marriage, and Religious Freedom

As we look to 2010, we will place our efforts in three main arenas. First we will focus on life. We will support life initiatives to protect the unborn, including informational events, prayer, and legislative measures---all as we call for unity to reflect God's will.

We will continue to support prayer efforts in general and the 40 Days for Life campaign in specific. We encourage all to be in prayer and, if possible, to physically stand in front of the Fargo abortion facility. Offer your prayers for the unborn, for those contemplating an abortion, and for the staff at the facility.

We will do our best to educate and inform. The country and the state are all moving more solidly toward opposing abortion, especially those 30 and under. In the legislative arena, we are researching opportunities to save unborn lives by addressing the definition of late term abortions.

Our second area of emphasis will be in promoting marriage, whether by faith-based events, seminars, or legislation. And when marriage is under attack, we will be there to stand in protection of the institution ordained by God.

Our third major initiative will be to protect our religious freedom. The 1st Amendment to the Constitution guaranteed our religious liberty, our North Dakota constitution provided for our religious freedoms in 1889, and now it is unclear whether our religious freedoms are protected, as intended.

NDFA is studying how best to guarantee our religious freedoms. If it is necessary to restore those freedoms by proposing an amendment to the ND Constitution, we will do so.
